NASA Research Announcement (NRA) 03-OBPR-04:

The National Space Biomedical Research Institute (NSBRI) is soliciting research proposals as part of a NASA Research Announcement (NRA) issued by the Office of Biological and Physical Research on April 15, 2003.

The NASA announcement, NRA 03-OBPR-04, solicits ground-based research proposals for the Biomedical Research and Countermeasures Program through two distinct opportunities: 1) independent investigator research projects or 2) proposals for an opportunity to become a member of an integrated countermeasure development team of the National Space Biomedical Research Institute.
