Neurologist with Sleep Medicine Specialization

Boston Medical Center (BMC) and Boston University School of Medicine (BUSM) is seeking a Board certified/eligible colleague with Neurology and Sleep Medicine specialization.

BMC houses a fully staffed, AASM-accredited 12-bed sleep laboratory, and has a well-developed fellowship (2 fellows per year) which is ACGME-accredited. It also includes 2 research beds. We are a Comprehensive Sleep Disorders Center with 2 board-certified sleep physicians and 1-2 advance practice providers. The Sleep Disorders Centers is supported by the Department of Psychiatry for Behavioral Sleep Medicine. There is also a strong relationship with the Departments of Otolaryngology and Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery. We have weekly sleep conferences, and provide integrated neurosciences care with strong patient-centered management. The Sleep Division is strongly integrated with the other divisions in the Department of Neurology at BMC, including Behavioral Neurology, Vascular Neurology, Neurocritical Care, Epilepsy, Movement Disorders, Multiple Sclerosis, Pain and General Neurology. Pediatric Neurology specialists are also heavily involved, and many sleep studies are done in children at our center as well.
